



# Group Health Research Institute: Steady growth & productivity in a time of transition


## Our performance in 2016

Group Health Research Institute reached a record-high \$51.6 million in grants and contracts while continuing to submit proposals and publish findings at a steady pace.


We navigated several important transitions: We prepared for Group Health’s 2017 acquisition by Kaiser Permanente, our long-time research partner, whose history, mission, and values closely align with ours. We planned for retirement of several senior investigators while welcoming seven new faculty members and recruiting two more. We met our goal of diversifying funding beyond traditional federal sources. Following unexpected U.S. election results, we are pivoting to focus more closely on proposals to the National Institutes of Health, our greatest source of support.

Building on solid progress in 2016, we anticipate an exciting future under our new banner: Kaiser Permanente Washington Health Research Institute!


Grant and contract revenue (in millions per year)




